



Library Resource Reconsideration Form

The Board of Directors of the Union Library Company of Hatboro (“ULCH”) has established a Collection Policy and a procedure for gathering input about particular items in its collection. The choice of library materials is an individual decision. While a person may reject titles for himself or his minor children, he cannot exercise censorship to restrict access to the material by others. Recognizing that a diversity of materials may result in some issues, the following form is in place to assure that ULCH receives feedback on its collections, and to provide Hatboro residents a way to inform us of their concerns.

Complete this form and submit it to the Director in person or at Director@HatboroLibrary.org. All completed forms will receive a written response within 60 days. If a patron wishes to appeal the Director’s decision, they may submit an appeal addressed to the Library’s Board of Directors, at the library’s address. Appeals will receive a written response within 60 days.
